ITINERARY:

Day 1 The Adventure starts by journeying through North Wales to Holyhead to take the 1200 sailing into Dublin city, from here we set off for our first hotel.

Day 2 While in Westport we visit Achill Island travelling via Newport & Mulrany, fantastic scenery.

Day 3 We also have a day at leisure in this fine town.

Day 4 We leave Westport and take a leisurely drive through Clifden and Galway heading south to our next hotel please Don't think this is a day in transit it is a day of wonderful scenery following the Atlantic coast and Galway Bay the earlier part of the day we pass underneath the Twelve Pin Mountains then later pass hundreds of small Loughs (Irish for lochs) along the way still heading south we then head West along the southern shore of Galway bay to Ballyvaughan which sits on the edge of Burren.

Day 5 Full day along the coast including Lisdoonvarna Irelands only spa town, Doolin and a sail to the Cliffs of Moher Included in tour price.

Day 6 Full day in the Burren visiting Ennis & Ennistmon.

Day 7 Sadly today we leave Ballyvaughan and head to Bray in Wicklow hopefully stopping in Athlone for lunch & Sightseeing the for our last day in Ireland tonight we stay at The Ramada Woodlands Court on the outskirts Bray.

Day 8 Our last day we spend the morning in Bray before we head for the 1330 Hi speed crossing from Dunlaoghaire arriving in Holyhead about 1545, and then arriving in the North West about 1800.
