



TENBY

This is Dunbych-y-Pysgod, the “little town of the fishes.” Best known today as both a medieval walled town and one of Wales’ favourite seaside resorts, Tenby is set in the only coastal National Park in Britain. Its ancient harbour, surrounded by Regency houses in pastel colours, is a magnet for artists and photographers. Its four sheltered beaches and safe bathing waters attract families throughout the season.

Tenby lies in a corner of Camarthen Bay, sheltered by Caldy Island, an ancient religious settlement which still houses a Cistercian community. The monks welcome visitors to the seclusion and rugged beauty of their refuge.
