

MINEHEAD

Minehead is an attractive and modern little resort on the southern shore of the Bristol Channel. It owed much of its early growth to the GWR (Great Western Railway, or "God's Wonderful Railway", as it came to be known following the rise to fame of the inspirational railway engineer, Isomard Kingdom Brunel).

In the 1960s, however, the now nationalised line was axed by the infamous Dr Beeching, only to be reborn as the charmingly preserved West Somerset Railway. In this guise, the tracks still lead to Minehead and help make this bustling resort everything it is today.
